Entry Fee: \$30

(\$20 for each additional division entered)

Senior Novice & Junior Novice Fee: \$20 (smaller medals will be awarded)

Spectator Fee: \$3 (YMCA fee for use of the facility)

Sanction: This tournament is sanctioned by the Oklahoma Judo Association, Class B member of USAJudo as an **Open Tournament**.

Eligibility: Any Judo player, currently an active member of USAJudo (USJI), USJA or USJF (membership in USAJudo may be acquired at the tournament).

Scoring System: Divisions with 5 or fewer will compete in the Pool System. Those with 6 or more will compete in Pool Knockout/Repechage System.

Seniors-5 minute matches; Juniors, Senior Novice & Masters-3 minute matches.

Divisions:

Masters Men (30+ years old, 10 year brackets: 30-39, 40-49, etc. Light, Middle & Heavy)

Masters Women (30 + years old, Light, Middle & Heavy)

Seniors Men Brown & Black Belt (National weights if possible, dependent on turnout),

Seniors Men Novice (White-Green Belts) Weights dependent upon turnout.

Senior Women Weights dependent upon turnout.

Junior Boys, Girls (5-16 years old): Age/Weight divisions dependent upon turnout.

Junior Novice Boys, Girls (5-16 years old who have competed in less than three tournaments)-
Age/Weight divisions dependent on turnout.

Kata: Katame-no-Kata, & Nage-no-Kata will be contested.

[Blue & Purple Belt Teens competing in the Senior Division will compete in the Brown & Black Belt Division.]; White-Green Belt Teens competing in the Senior Division will compete in the Senior Novice Division.]

(Juniors who are at least 13 years old may also compete in the Senior Divisions for the additional fee; Masters may also compete in the Senior Divisions for the additional fee. No junior will compete against anyone more than 15% heavier, unless requesting to be moved up from an uncontested division by the coach, parent or competitor).

The Tournament Director reserves the right to make modifications to the weight and age divisions to make competition by combining divisions where the competitor would otherwise be uncontested.

Set Up & Rules: 2 mats will be used; Current IJF Rules & Sporting code will be in effect with standard modifications concerning Shime-waza & Kansetsu-waza for juniors. U.S. National rules will be in effect for situations not covered by the IJF rules (i.e.: Vacating uncontested divisions, etc.)

Awards: Each 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner will receive a medal. Novice division medals will be different than regular division medals.

Team Trophies: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place Team Trophies will be awarded at the end of the tournament based on the following point system:

Regular divisions: 1st=5 pts.; Uncontested 1st=2.5 pts.; 2nd=3 pts.; 3rd=2 pts.

Novice Divisions: 1st=3 pts.; Uncontested 1st=1.5 pts.; 2nd=2 pts.; 3rd=1 pt.

Senior & Sr. Novice competition: 10 minutes after completion of Junior's awards;

WAIVER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY & AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, in any Judo tournament, practice, clinic & related events & activities of U.S. Judo, Inc. operating as USA Judo, Oklahoma Judo Association, Tulsa Judo Club, & the Thornton Family YMCA.

I hereby:

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo & understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that, prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, & the elimination or scoring system to be used. If I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor &/or a tournament official of such conditions & refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge & fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury including permanent disability or death & severe social & economic losses due not only to my own actions, in-actions or negligence, but also to the actions, in-actions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks & accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
